



Naisp.net continues Build-out of Affordable Fixed Wireless Broadband

North Attleborough MA (November 21, 2001) – Naisp.net, the Internet division of North Attleborough Electric Department (NAED) launched a high-speed wireless product in the North Attleborough Industrial Park in August 2001. Greenwood Fire & Apparatus and Action Automation & Controls, two Industrial Park tenants, agreed to test the system.

The wireless equipment was evaluated during the test period, which was a success. Action Automation's V. P. of Information Technologies Randal M. Goneau commented after the test that "the service and availability of the personnel involved exceeded my expectations." He also said, "After fruitless calls to our other ISP, I called naisp.net once and explained my situation. You (naisp.net) had us up and running wirelessly in two days with full T1 speed."

Ray Larocque of Greenwood Fire & Apparatus had the following to say of naisp.net wireless: "Now that we have been using your Wireless Internet Provider Service for several months I would like to let you know how pleased we are with the speed and the reliability. Our Sales and Service staff are now using the Internet more for research, and sending orders to our vendors. Through the process of setting up the Wireless Connection the time you and your staff spent with us explaining each step of the plan was much appreciated."

Along with offering wireless services in the Industrial Park, naisp.net has worked with the North Attleborough School Department. Providing a customized wireless solution to the Middle School on Landry Avenue, naisp.net connects approximately 1,500 school computers to the Internet.

By the end of November, naisp.net will have the infrastructure build-out completed. This will include the placement of two additional Relay Nodes near Towne Street and John Dietsch Square, which are designed to cover the remaining sections of the Industrial Park with a wireless link. With the expansion of this wireless project further into the Industrial Park, tenants can purchase a high-speed access plan with five emails and web hosting for a monthly service charge starting at \$198.

Naisp.net fixed wireless service offers the Industrial Park an affordable broadband alternative to the expensive dedicated digital circuits, which up until now was the only option. High-speed wireless broadband Internet access from naisp.net is not only more affordable, but quickly installed. The customer premise equipment (CPE) can be installed within a week compared to four to six weeks required for digital circuits.
